GREATER VANCOUVER TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY BY-LAW NO. 24-2002

A By-Law to Amend the Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority 2001 Tariff Amendment By-Law Number 22-2001 (as amended)

WHEREAS the Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority (GVTA) has an interest in maintaining the reciprocal arrangement with BC Transit for Government of BC Bus Pass holders and the GVTA has agreed to allow holders of Government of BC Bus Passes issued outside the Greater Vancouver Transportation service region to be valid in the TransLink conventional system (Bus, SeaBus and SkyTrain).

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority enact as follows:

- 1. The Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority Transit Tariff annexed to the "Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority 2001 Tariff Amendment By-law No. 22, 2001", is hereby amended as follows:
 - A) In "GVTA Transit System Transit Tariff, Part I Conventional Transit, Section B Terms and Conditions" by replacing the paragraphs under "Government of British Columbia Transit Pass" with the following paragraphs:

Government of British Columbia Transit Pass

Available: To eligible persons as determined by the Ministry of Human

Resources. Government of British Columbia passes are

identification cards which incorporate design features specified and approved by the GVTA and are issued by the Ministry of Human Resources of the Province of British Columbia, in accordance with an agreed contractual arrangement with the

GVTA.

Applicable: To a journey made on regular scheduled service within the

GVTA Transportation Service Region except West Coast

Express.

Conditions: Only valid if issued for the Greater Vancouver Transportation

Authority or BC Transit as shown on the face of the pass. Not valid on buses operating Charter Service or Custom Transit

vehicles. The pass is not transferable.

- 2. This By-law may be cited as the Greater Vancouver Transportation Authority 2002 Tariff Amendment By-law No. 24-2002.
- 3. This By-law comes into force and takes effect immediately.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME this 19th day of April 2002. RECONSIDERED, PASSED AND FINALLY ADOPTED this 19th day of April 2002.
