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# So Long, Number 17!

With a tear and a cheer, it's time to bid the Oak Street cars good-bye!

Forty years and three months they've served . . . you and you and you . . . taking you out to Marpole, bringing you in to town.

They've practically knocked themselves out doing it, rocking, twisting, clicking over switches, grinding up the Cambie Hill. The cars deserve a rest—and come Friday, they'll be getting it. For good!

Later on this year, after the paving is finished on Oak Street, trolley coaches will skim along where the old Number 17's clanked by.

Meanwhile, we'll be serving the folks on this route with two temporary bus lines, about which more in a moment.





To those of you who use this line, a word of caution: Prepare for Detours! They're plenty of 'em ahead before the big paving job is finished. We'll do our best to advise you when the route is going to change, and how. But even that may not always be possible, because the notice reaches us, sometimes, too late to broadcast much warning.

\* \* \*

So we're asking you folks to bear with the fuss and feathers that always accompany a major improvement like this. When the dust settles you'll find a magnificent thoroughfare running past your door, with spanking new trolley coaches, better street lighting, and so on.

Now, about the two temporary bus routes. These will replace the Oak Street streetcar service on Friday, April 18th.


One bus route will operate from Victory Square to Connaught Drive and Oak. The other will operate from Marpole to Granville and 41st.

\* \* \*

As you see, this is going to leave a portion of the present Oak Street route—between 30th and 41st Avenues — without transit service. We're very sorry about this, but there just aren't any suitable streets to operate over in this particular area.

#### North Route

As shown on the accompanying map, temporary bus service will sort Friday from Hamilton and Pender via Pender, Cambie, Dunsmuir, Hamilton, Robson, Cambie, Broadway, Oak, King Edward, Osler to Devonshire Crescent, loop-



ing via Devonshire Crescent, Oak and Connaught, and returning downtown over the same route. This routing, of course, will change as detours for paving work necessitate.

Those dotted lines on the map are the detour routes which will be followed in coming months. The map also shows the various stops. Solid line shows the route that will be followed, effective Friday.

NOTE: On Cambie Street between Broadway and the Bridge, the present bus stops rather than street car stops will be used. There will be no stops on the bridge itself.

### South Route

As shown on the accompanying map, the temporary bus route will start Friday from Marpole Loop via Marine, Osler, 59th, Hudson, 41st and Granville to 40th Avenue, and return over the same route.

Passengers for downtown may transfer to the Granville trolley coach at 41st.

This routing will be followed until a sufficient amount of Oak Street has been paved to allow a more normal routing.
