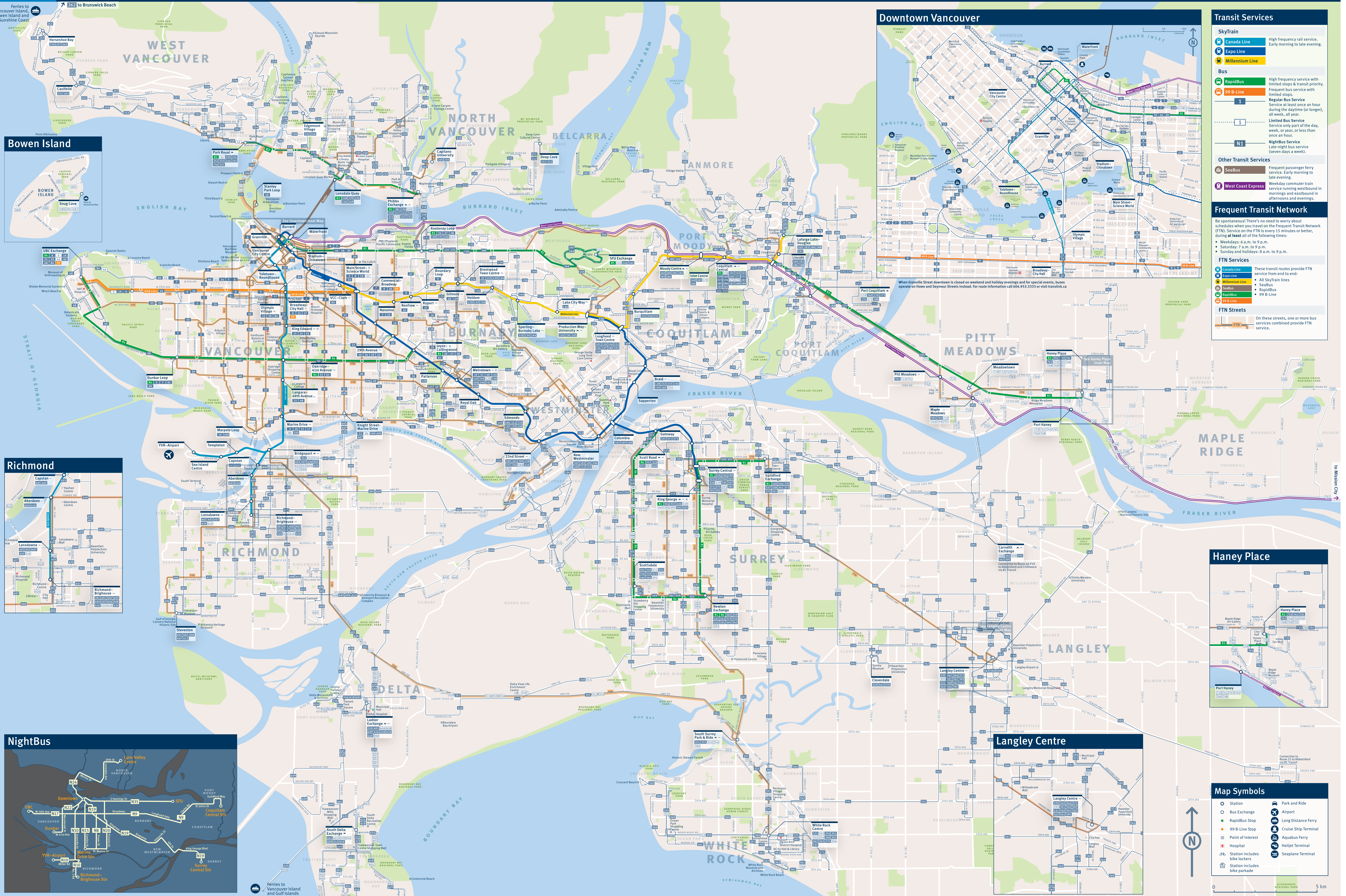


T Metro Vancouver Transit Map

Transit Services

- SkyTrain**
- Canada Line: High frequency rail service. Early morning to late evening.
 - Expo Line: High frequency rail service. Early morning to late evening.
 - Millennium Line: High frequency rail service. Early morning to late evening.
- Bus**
- RapidBus: High frequency service with limited stops & transit priority. Frequent bus service with limited stops.
 - 99 B-Line: Regular Bus Service. Service at least once an hour during the daytime (or longer), all week, all year.
 - 1: Limited Bus Service. Service only part of the day, week, or year, or less than once an hour.
 - N1: NightBus Service. Late-night bus service (seven days a week).

Other Transit Services

- SeaBus: Frequent passenger ferry service. Early morning to late evening.
- West Coast Express: Weekday commuter train service running westbound in mornings and eastbound in afternoons and evenings.

Frequent Transit Network

Be spontaneous! There's no need to worry about schedules when you travel on the Frequent Transit Network (FTN). Service on the FTN is every 15 minutes or better, during at least all of the following times:

- Weekdays: 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- Saturday: 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- Sunday and holidays: 8 a.m. to 9 p.m.

- FTN Services**
- Canada Line: These transit routes provide FTN service from end to end:
 - Expo Line: All SkyTrain lines
 - Millennium Line: RapidBus
 - SeaBus: RapidBus
 - 99 B-Line: RapidBus
 - 1: RapidBus
- FTN Streets**
- On these streets, one or more bus services combined provide FTN service.
